

St John the Baptist RC School Impact of Pupil Premium for 16-17

For 16-17 -The funding was attached to 11 pupils.

It was spent on:-

- Additional teachers to support those who are low attaining and to improve rates of progress, in small focused groups or one to one
- Additional teaching assistant support to enable those who are low attaining or to improve rates of progress, including daily reading
- Funding the Thrive program and continued training in Thrive
- Support in paying for disadvantaged pupils on residential or school trips
- Numbers count teacher delivering 1:1 tuition
- Afterschool homework club
- 1:1 counselling
- 1:1 tutoring on the computer via Third Space Learning
- Counting to calculating intervention in mathematics for pupils from years 2-4.

The impact of this was:-

- 100% of pupil premium pupils reached a GLD in the Foundation stage
- 100% of pupil premium pupils passed the phonics test at the end of Year 1
- 100% of pupil premium pupils who retook the phonics test in Year 2 passed it
- 100% of pupils premium pupils reached the expected standard in reading and writing and mathematics at the end of Year 2
- All pupil premium pupils across the school made better than expected progress in reading, writing and mathematics with the strongest progress being in reading
- 100% of pupil premium pupils made expected progress at the end of Key stage 2 in reading and writing.
- 50%(1 out of 2) reached the expected standard in mathematics at the end of Key stage 2.
