## COVID

We have had some cases of Covid amongst pupils. We have attached another copy of the letter that was sent out earlier in the week which gives clear advice on testing regularly. This is particularly important to pick up asymptomatic cases where there are no symptoms but someone may be carrying Covid. If you or your child tests positive then please can you notify the school. Thank you.

### WORLD BOOK DAY

World Book Day falls on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> of March. Children can come in dressed as their favourite book character and there will be a range of activities on the day to promote a love of reading.

#### **EWO (EDUCATION WELFARE OFFICER)**

The EWO has visited the school and asked us to write to a number of parents concerning attendance. Where your child's attendance is below 90% (persistent absentees), then you may receive one of these letters in the next week. Where there are a lot of medical absences we have been advised to request medical certification of this if we don't already have it on file. This may be an online consult, prescription bottle etc. Attendance of 90% is like a child missing 1 year of education for every 10 years. Attendance of 80% is like missing 1 year every 5 years. As you can imagine, this has an adverse effect on how well your child does in school as they are missing vast amounts of their education. Once a child's attendance drops below 90% they are known as persistent absentees. The EWO looks very closely at these children (as does Ofsted) and becomes involved if attendance does not improve. We have attached the School's Attendance Policy which is also available on our website. We take Covid absences into account when we look at children's attendance levels. Please do not worry if your child has had Covid but outside of this, they have good attendance. Holidays are not normally authorised and the EWO will be monitoring holidays taken during term time. Holiday forms should be filled out for all holidays take during term time. Please feel free to come and discuss anything to do with attendance with us.
